

HOW TO READ SHEET MUSIC

This is a 'Treble Clef' and shows notes that have to be played with your right hand (Pianists)

This is a 'Time Signature' which tells us how many beats are allowed in each bar

This is a 'Bar Line' which separate each 'Bar'

The notes between the lines of the treble clef spell out the word 'FACE'

Notes on the lines of the treble clef spell out "EGBDF" or an easy way to remember is 'Every Good Boy Deserves Fun'

This is 'Middle C' which is below 'FACE' and 'EGBDF' it is also the middle note of a piano

This is a 'Bass Clef' and shows notes that have to be played with your left hand (Pianists)

The notes between the lines spell out 'ACEG' or an easy way to remember is 'All Cows Eat Grass'. Notice that these notes are different from the notes of the same position on the treble clef

The notes on the lines spell out 'GBDFA' or an easy way to remember is 'Good Boys Deserve Fun Always'. Notice that these notes are different from the notes of the same position on the treble clef

This is 'Middle C' which is above 'ACEG' and 'GBDFA' it is also the middle note of a piano
